

CITY-COUNTY POLICE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT FISCAL ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2009
Proposal No. 318, 2009

A POLICE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT FISCAL ORDINANCE establishing the annual rate of taxation and tax levy for the year 2010 for the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police District Fund, and fixing a time when this ordinance shall take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE POLICE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS AND OF MARION COUNTY, INDIANA

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied and assessed or confirmed as may be required by law on all real estate and improvements and all business personal property of whatever description, tangible and intangible, and choses in action of every kind and character in the Police Special Service District of the City of Indianapolis, as assessed and returned for taxation in said District for the year 2009, payable in 2010, a tax rate of thirty-one and ninety-nine hundredths cents (\$0.3199) for the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Fund on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) valuation of such special service district taxable property.
