CITY-COUNTY FISCAL ORDINANCE NO. _____, 2009

A FISCAL ORDINANCE amending the City-County Annual Budget for 2009 (City-County Fiscal Ordinance No. 54, 2008) by appropriating Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) in the County General Fund for purposes of the Marion County Circuit Court.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY-COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS AND OF MARION COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. To provide for expenditures the necessity for which has arisen since the adoption of the annual budget, Section 1.06(e) of the City-County Annual Budget for 2009 be, and is hereby, amended by the increases and reductions hereinafter stated for purposes of the Marion County Circuit Court to fund the following: the purchase of paper products and other general office supplies to support the general administration of the court for the remainder of 2009, financed by a transfer between characters in the court's County General Fund appropriations.

SECTION 2. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) be, and the same appropriated for the purposes as shown in Section 3 by reducing the accounts as shown in Section 4, where applicable.

SECTION 3. The following increased appropriation is hereby approved:
