CITY-COUNTY FISCAL ORDINANCE NO. , 2009

A FISCAL ORDINANCE amending the City-County Annual Budget for 2009 (City-County Fiscal Ordinance No. 54, 2008) appropriating Ninety Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Five Dollars (\$92,485) in the Sheriff's Medical Care for Inmates Fund for purposes of the Marion County Sheriff's Department and reducing certain other accounts for that agency, where applicable.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY-COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS AND OF MARION COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. To provide for expenditures the necessity for which has arisen since the adoption of the annual budget, Section 1.08 (b) of the City-County Annual Budget for 2009 be, and is hereby, amended by the increases and reductions hereinafter stated to pay for prescription drugs used in treating inmates incarcerated in Marion County, financed by revenues collected from health care and prescription drug co-payments by inmates.

SECTION 2. The sum of Ninety Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Five Dollars (\$92,485) be, and the same is hereby transferred and appropriated for the purposes as shown in Section 3 by reducing the accounts as shown in Section 4, where applicable.

SECTION 3. The following additional appropriation is hereby approved:
