In January, 2004 Mike Rodman took office as the Treasurer for Marion County. The Marion County Treasurer has the assigned authority to collect, invest and distribute property taxes and to provide financial analysis related to those functions. He is president of the Marion County Commissioners and the Marion County Board of Finance. He chairs the Marion County Information Technology Board and is a member of the Police Pension Board and serves on the board for the Marion County Guardian Home.

Mr. Rodman's professional career was in banking and he held the position of First Vice President and Manager of Community Relations with Bank One, Indiana. He helped create one of the nation's first bank owned community development corporation and was instrumental in its role of assisting revitalization work of many neighborhoods in Indianapolis. Mike graduated from Shortridge High School, and received both a B.S. and M.B.A. from Indiana University. Mike currently serves on the Advisory Board of the Indianapolis Urban League and is vice chairman of Historic Landmarks Foundation, Inc. Mike is a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church, concerned Clergy, and 100 Black Men. Active in politics, Mike is a Ward Chairmen, precinct committee person, and a member of the Democratic Party Chairman's Club. Mike is married and has two adult children. His son is currently serving active duty in the Navy.
